0333 – Azpilicueta to Reñada - 30th July 2022

A sporting through trip was conducted between the above two entrances. Entering in 0333, the first short 10 metre pitch was found *not* to be rigged (is there more than one way down?), but a hanger was installed and left in-situ for a pull through. Beyond the first pitch, all of the subsequent pitches were found to be excellently rigged with chains for a pull through, and traverse lines to pitch heads had been left in-situ in varying degrees of condition, but all quite useable. There was a deviation on the final pitch which was in good condition and useable. Markers were present for route finding on the horizontal sections in-between pitches.

The route was well marked from the bottom of the final pitch to the Pipe Cleaner connection point with Reñada, however the route in Sanatogen Passage (at the bottom of the Pipe Cleaner) was poorly marked and there were some minor difficulties finding the way. Once into Stuffed Monk Galleries in Reñada, the route was very well marked to the exit.
